Through "New Orleans Lagniappe," delegates can be inspired by nature via a swamp tour through an ancient cypress studded bayou, choose to board "The Creole Queen" Paddlewheel River Boat for a cruise to Historic Chalmette Battlefield, where costumed re-enactors will bring to life the 1815 Battle of New Orleans, or meander through the French Quarter, admiring the architecture, exploring the French Market, and indulging in café au lait and beignets at the world famous Café Dumonde.
